


BON VOYAGE (29-05-2021)





INTERNATIONAL YOGA AND MUSIC DAY


On 1st July 2021, NSS volunteers of Sree Narayana College, Alathur




ANTI-DOWRY LAW(Awareness class) 19-07-2021






WOMEN and SOCIETY (Webinar) 24-07-2021








<u>YOUTH DAY</u> (12-08-2021)

Finally the 7 days residential camp was concluded by taking group photos. All the NSS volunteers said goodbye with grief.






JANUARY
