Decentralization & Participation in the Institutional Governance

The college has an effective decentralization and participative management. Governing body of the college is headed by Principal; staff council consisting of heads of all departments, librarian, superintendent and two elected teachers and student representatives. The college has a Regional Development Council (R.D.C.), headed by a convener and Principal is the ex-officio member of RDC, to look after its immediate requirements.

Head of the Departments and teachers conduct departmental meetings to discuss, plan and decide the academic, non-academic works to be done for each academic year.

Different committees like purchase committee, discipline committees are formed to supplement the growth of institution which are all headed and managed by teachers. At the beginning of each academic year different committees and clubs are formed by involving teaching staff and students which help the institution in promoting the participative management. Co-coordinators of these clubs and committees are nominated by the Principal and council members.

NCC, NSS, Anti-Ragging Cell, Internal Complaints Committee, Anti Narcotic Cell and Counseling centre is also functioning in the institution to effectively resolve the issues of students and ensure a positive hassle free ambience in the campus. Women Development Cell of the institution ensures participation and active involvement girl students in all the

programmes and thereby assures upliftment of women. Grievance redressal cell is also formed to address the grievances of the students as well as the staff and take appropriate measures to redress them.

In order to guide the students in deciding and choosing their career, Career Guidance cell is also developed. Under the leadership of Career Guidance cell different Job fairs and career development programmes are also organized by ensuring participation of maximum number of students. Every year the Purchase committee collects academic and infrastructure requirements from each department and makes arrangements for purchasing and providing essential items needed.

In order to guide advice and monitor the overall activities of college union, a faculty from teaching fraternity is selected as staff advisor and for arts activities an arts advisor and a staff editor for the college magazine is also appointed. The Principal, Staff Advisor, Arts Advisor, council members and PTA members helps the union to plan and execute various arts, cultural, sports and philanthropic activities. Student IQAC also actively functioning in the campus.

IQAC ensures the presence of a student representative from the College Union in all its important meetings. Students are also given the opportunity to engage in governance through democratically elected College Union. The college union organizes all the cultural events, debate and literary activities.

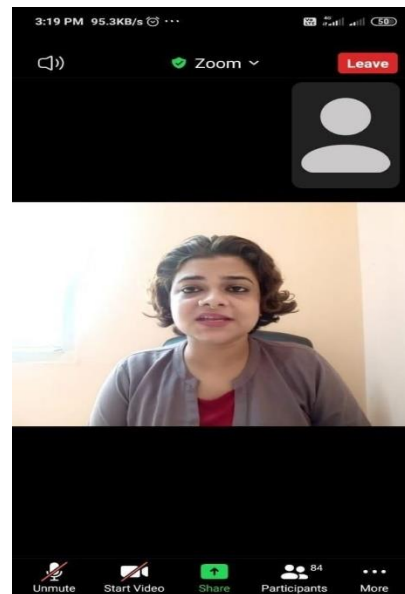
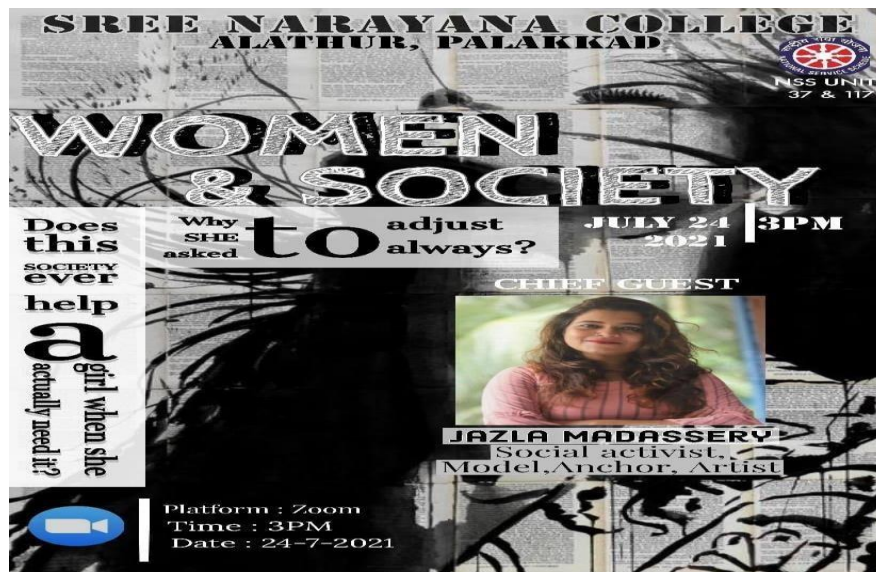
