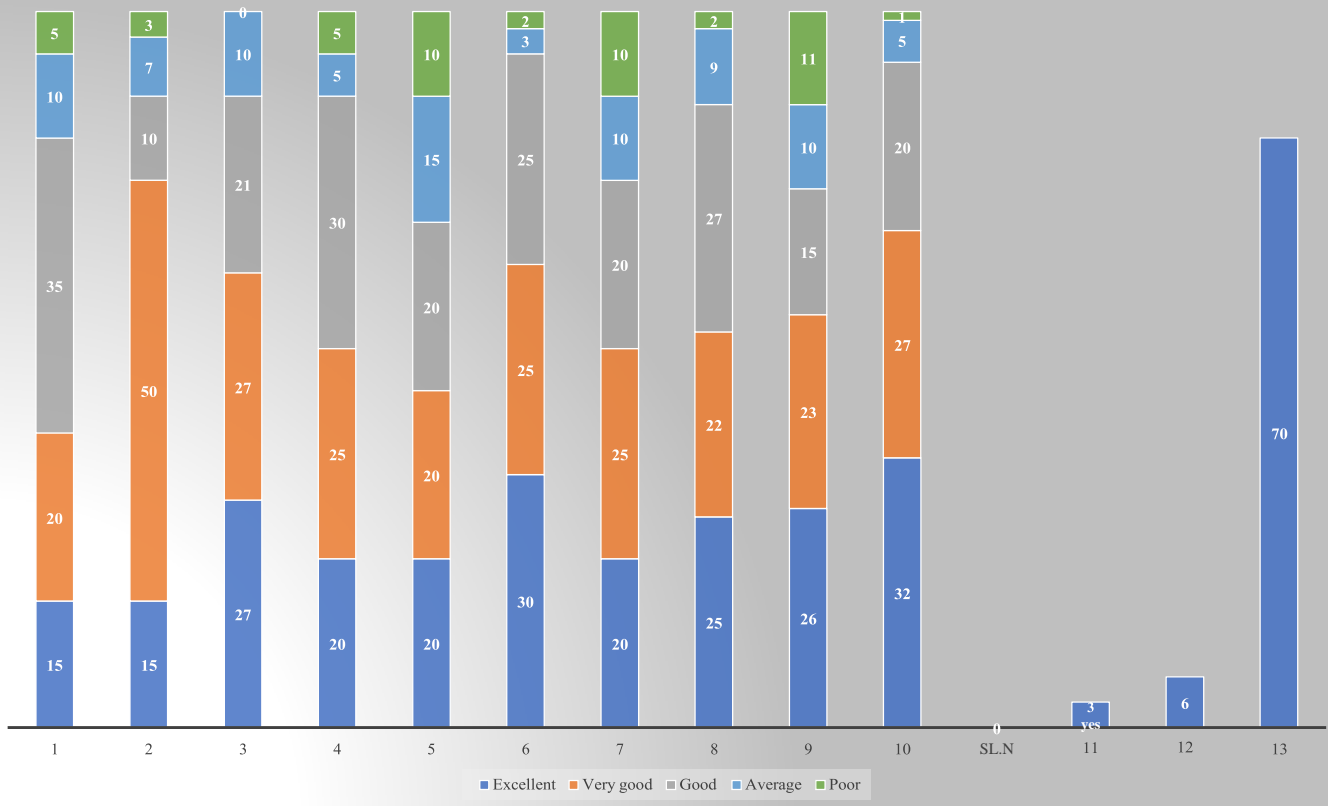

Students' Feedback Chart 2018-2019

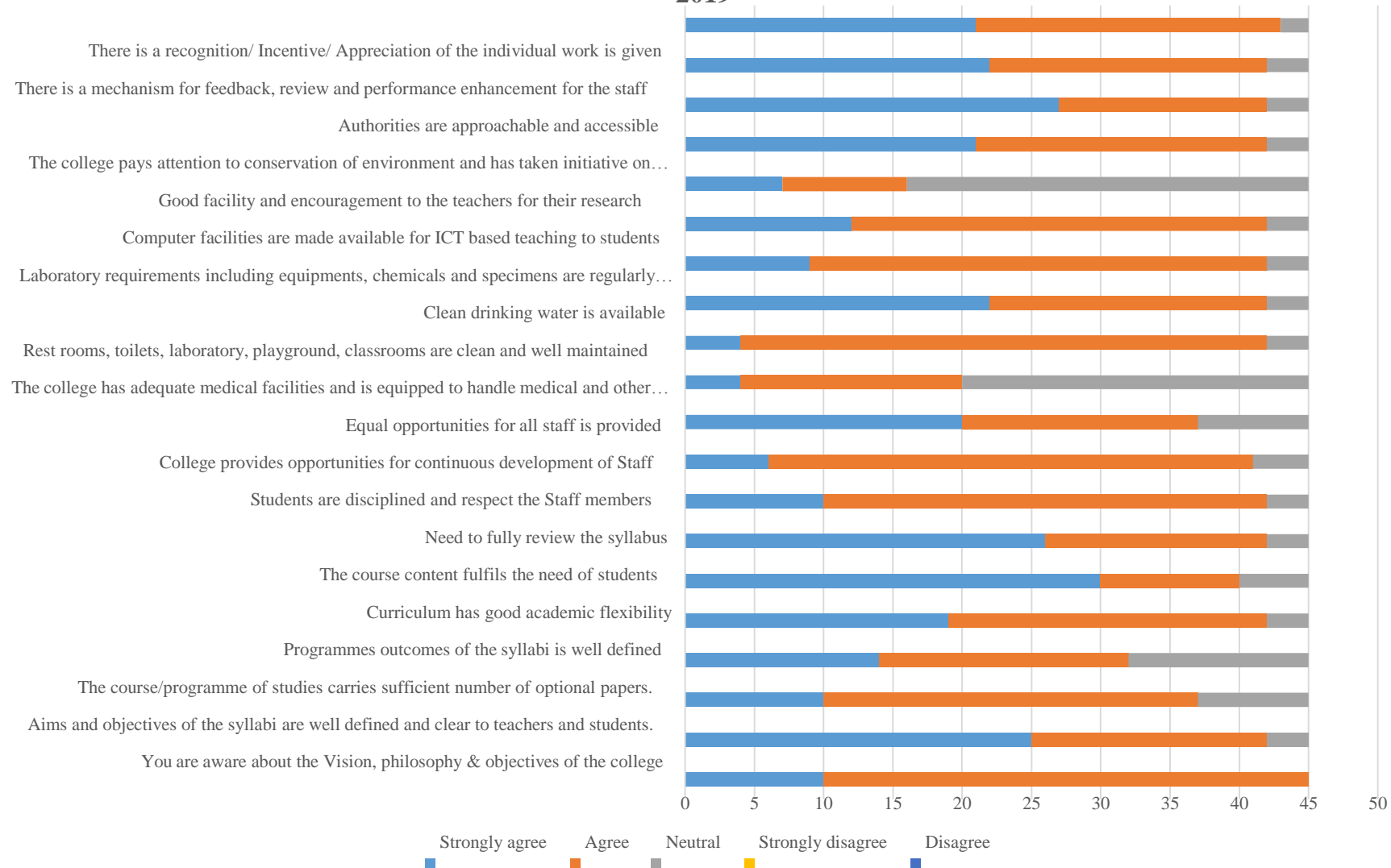

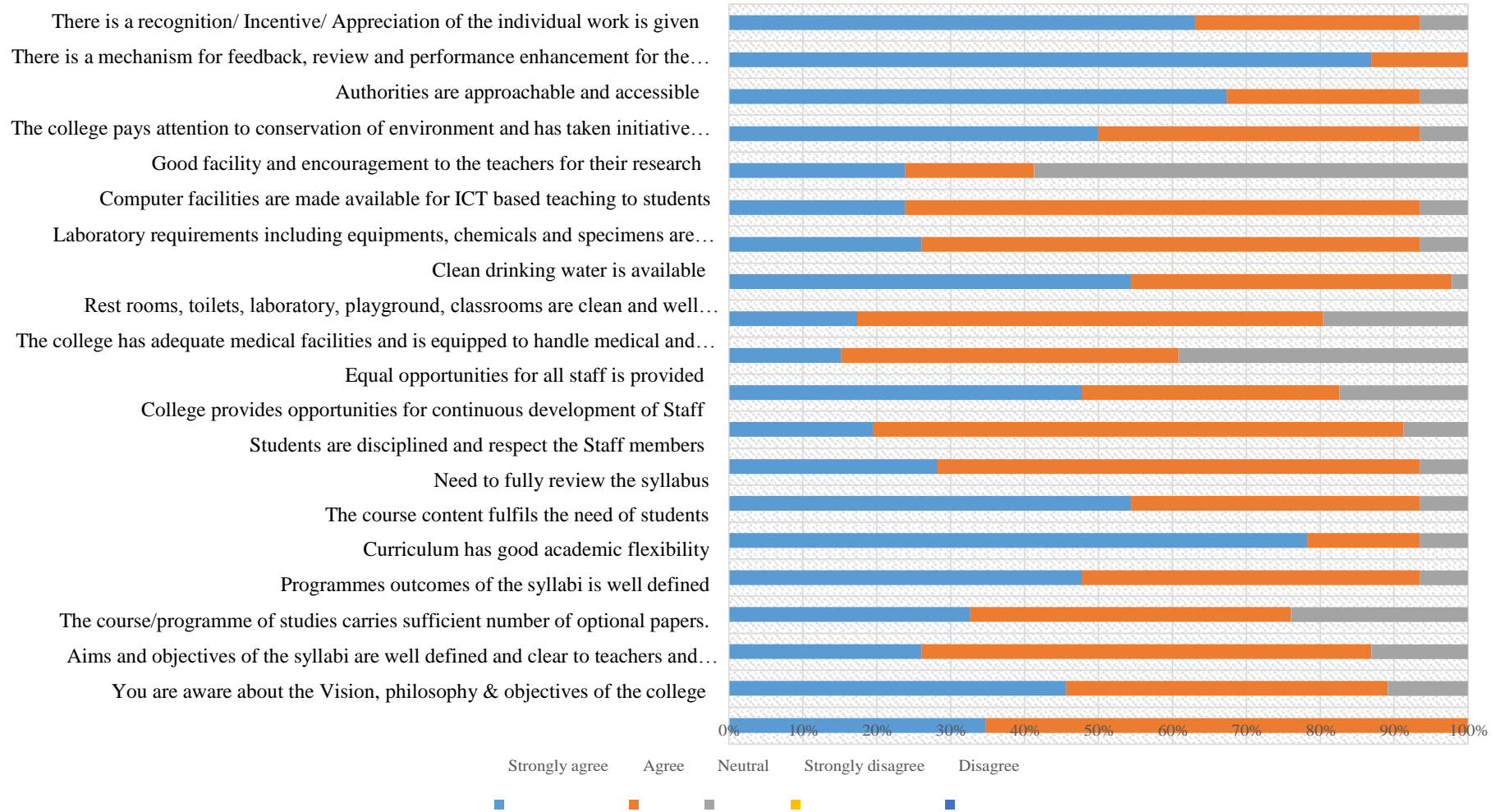
Students' Feedback Chart 2019 - 2020

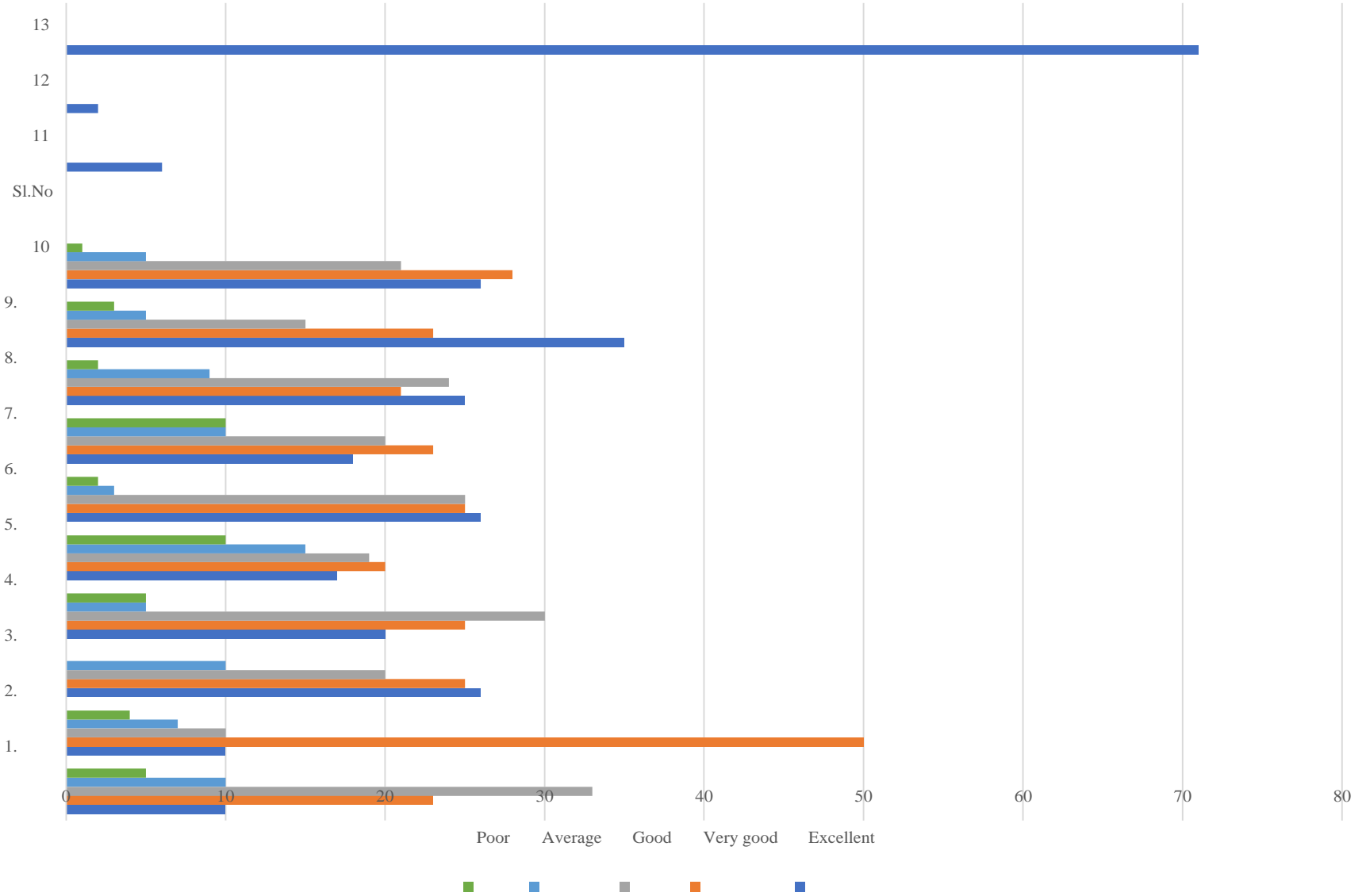
Teachers' feedback Chart 2019 - 2020

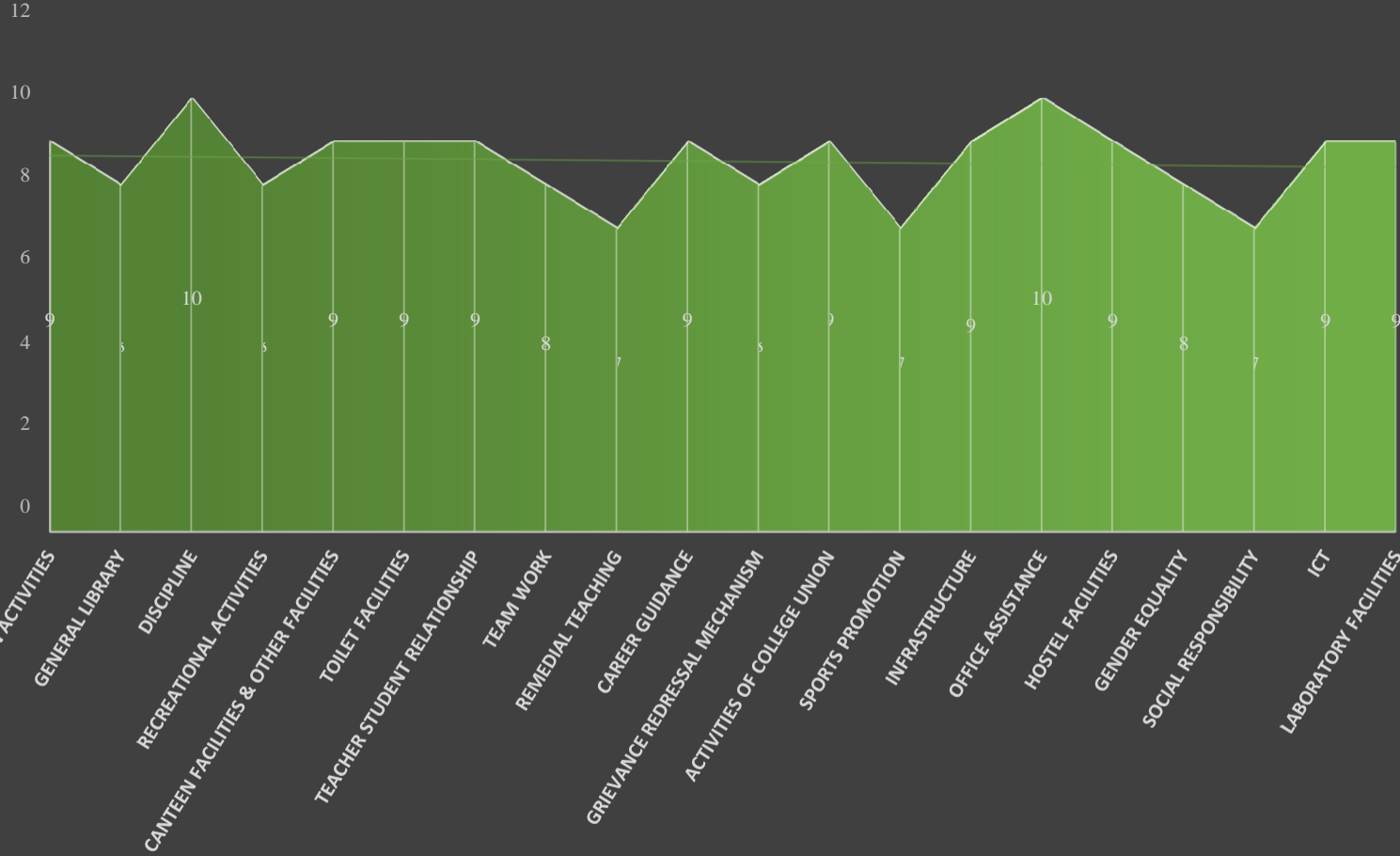

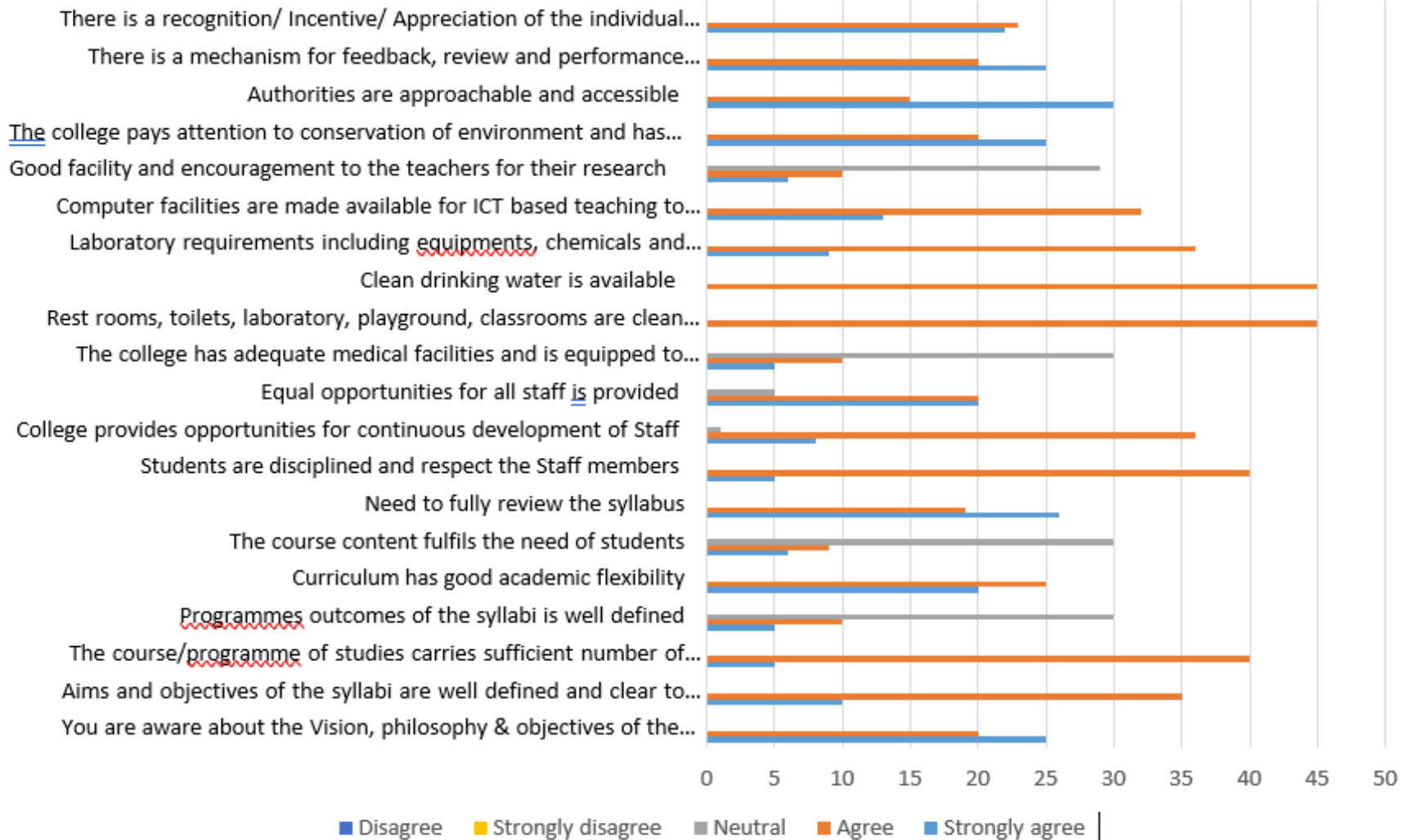
Students' feedback Chart 2020 - 2021

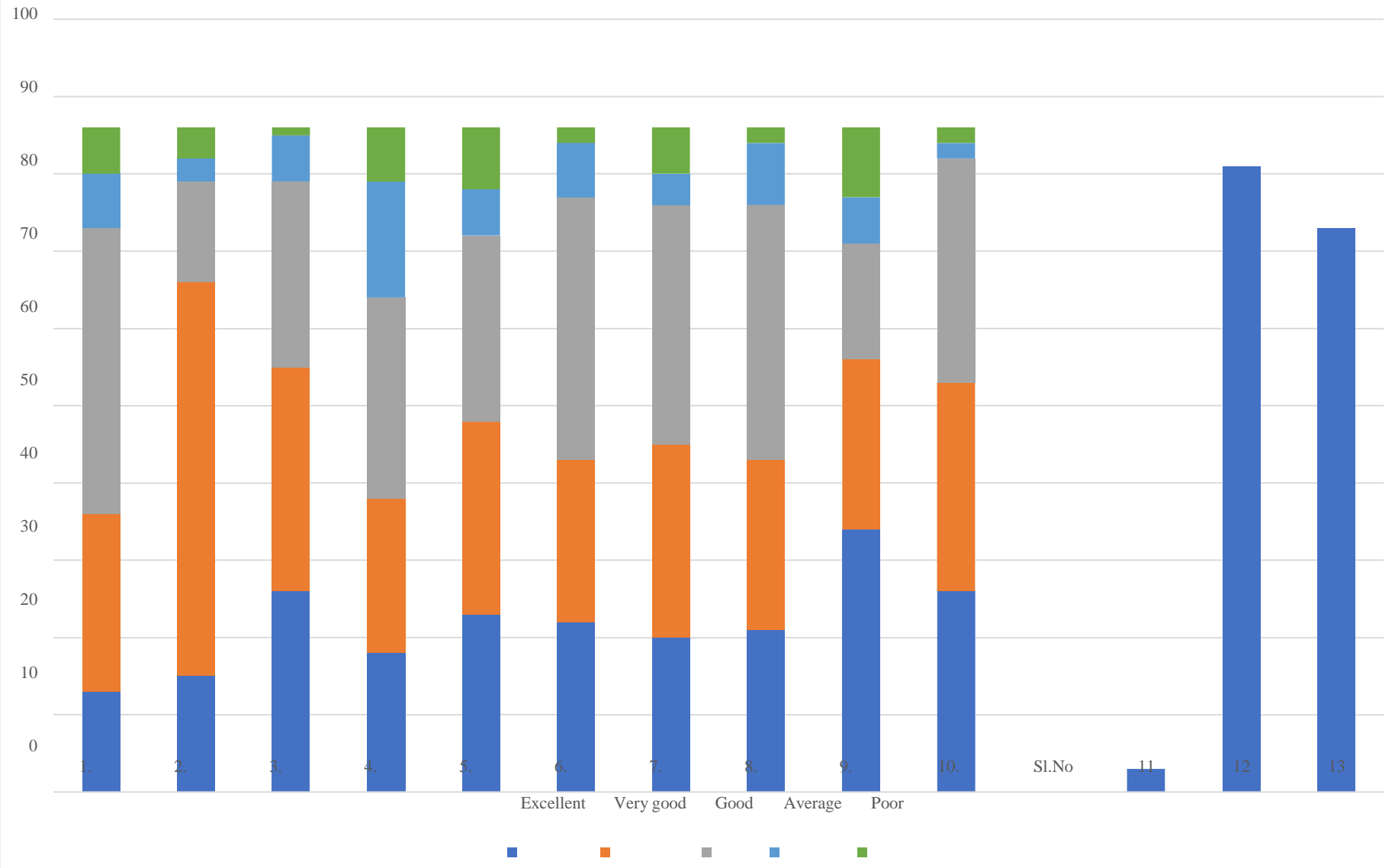
