The Green Audit/Environment Audit aims to analyse environmental practices within and outside the college campus, which will have an impact on the eco-friendly ambience. It was initiated with the motive of inspecting the work conducted within the organizations whose exercises can cause risk to the health of inhabitants and the environment. It is the process of assessing the environmental impact of an organization, process, project, product etc. Green Audit can be defined as a basic management tool comprising a systematic, documented, periodic and objective evaluation of how well environmental organisations, management systems and equipment are performing.

An **Energy Audit** is an inspection, survey and analysis of energy flow for energy conservation in a building, process or system to reduce the amount of energy input into the system without negatively affecting the output. Reducing energy consumption while maintaining or improving human comfort, health and safety are of primary concern. The primary objective of energy audit is to determine ways to reduce energy consumption per unit of product output or to lower operating cost. Energy audit provides a "benchmark" (Reference point) for managing energy in the organization and also provides the basis for planning a more effective use of energy throughout the organization.

Sree Narayana College, Alathur campus spread over 21 acres of land, more than 17 acres are enriched with bio diversity and the green campus initiatives. The campus is also benefited by solar energy (around 6 KW) in the form of solar lights and other forms. The campus installed solar power generation – two numbers with an installed capacity of 4KW each, the electricity generated is supplied to the common grid, being owned by the Kerala State Electricity Board Ltd., along with solar flood lights – three numbers of 30W each for night-time lighting of the campus. Groundwater recharge facility also maintained throughout the campus. As a continuous process of protecting environment, the college conducts survey in every academic year by collecting the samples of air, water and soil of our

campus. It has been found that the bio-diversity of the campus reduces pollution and we have taken measures to improve the purity of the above systems by planting trees and ground -water recharging, reduced use of plastics etc. The audit team collect all relevant information through the observation of the campus, the neighbourhood, adjacent roads, traffic intensity, dust level, movement of staff and students, waste dumps, industries in the region, etc. Besides, NSS formed a unit named Haritha Karma Sena, with the aim of management of plastic waste regularly. They collect all the plastic waste in association with Kavassery Grama Panchayath. For this, women employees are appointed by them. There are three types of bins used in the campus for plastic waste management: Green, blue and red. NSS units also take initiative to collects e-waste and reusable materials are categorized and the balance are sold as scrap. The college in association with KSEB conducts quiz competition with a view to promote solar energy in every year.

The green audit and energy audit including evaluation of Biodiversity conservation have been conducted by the science departments internally until 2021 for the promotion of sustainable living and education in a healthy environment. From the year 2021-2022 onwards the college has decided to do the quality audits especially green audit / environmental audit and energy audit with the help of an external agency. The detailed report provided by them are given below.

In our opinion, the Institution has presented before the audit team true and up-to-date data on the various aspects of working of this higher education institution, and appropriate audit procedures have been completed for preparing this report. The assessments and recommendations are based on data presented before the team at the time of audit.

The audit methodology did combine physical inspection of the campus on several work days and holidays, with analytical reviews of relevant documents and activities, as well as interviews with the designated Staff and Students of the College.

This audit is conducted to ensure that a Green lifestyle is followed and implemented in the campus across all academic and non-academic departments, as well as the body of students undergoing studies in the College.

Green Audit 2021-'22 of S N College, Alathur, Kerala has found that the institution's per capita carbon footprint for the year is only 0.159 ton of CO₂ equivalent, a level well below the current 2021 national per capita average of 1.84 t CO₂, with **potential to develop soon into a carbon neutral campus**. All efforts are taken to conserve, protect, and enrich the existing biodiversity and also to extend efforts even beyond the college boundary through outreach, and further by implementing the Green Protocol, and having a commitment to continue its green practices to positively impact the society at large.



Environment Audit for the academic year 2021- '22 has been conducted at S N College, Alathur, Palakkad 678 682, Kerala in accordance with the International Standards for ISO 14000 family of standards set by ISO TC 207 and its Subcommittees, Biological Diversity Act 2002, Environmental Protection Act 1986 (and amendments) of Government of India, and other relevant mandates for maintaining sustainable and healthy environment for education in the campus.

In our opinion, the Institution has presented true and up-to-date data on the various aspects of working of this education institution, and appropriate audit procedures have been completed by the audit team for issuing this Audit Certificate and Compliance Statement. The recommendations are based on verified data presented on the situation as they existed at the time of audit.

The audit methodology did combine physical inspection of the campus on several occasions, with analytical reviews of relevant documents and activities, as well as interviews with the Principal, selected Staff members and Students of the College.

Audit findings indicate that, of the 285.3 T CO_2 of actual carbon footprint of the institution for the year, the contribution from Transportation and mobility including public transport use is at 223.5 T CO_2 – with 39.1 T only coming from the use of personal vehicles by staff and students, and that out of Wastes is at 20.3 T CO_2 . The remedial activities contributed an overall relief of 56.6 T CO_2 . The campus is maintained clean, and tidy. Environmental Quality in the campus of 1440 (population) is GOOD.

Carbon Footprint Analysis and Evaluation for 2021-'22

The actual per capita carbon footprint for S N College, Alathur, Palakkad, Kerala is 198 kg (0.198 Ton) of CO_2 equivalent [285.3 Ton/(1419 + 21 visitors] during the year 2021-22. With an offset of 56.6 TCO₂ obtained through remedial actions, the net carbon footprint during 2021-'22 is thus [285.3 - 56.6 = 228.7 T CO_2 eq.].

The effective CF per capita is 228.7/1440 or 0.159 T or 159 kg CO2 per capita [2021-22]

According to the Economic Survey of Govt. of India, for an Indian in 2021 in 2021 the per capita emission is 1.84 Ton $CO_{2 \text{ eq.}}$ per annum. It is projected to increase by 1% in 2022. India's effort for greening is gaining ground with visible lowering of carbon footprints.

For the year 2021-'22, for S N College, Alathur, Kerala, the Carbon Footprint per capita at 0.159 T CO₂ equivalent, is very modest. This is achieved due to the minimal use of resources, increased participation in eco-efficient mobility practices, and experimental introduction of moderate remedial measures like the use of renewable energy and recycling.

The campus is a 'low carbon footprint' institution, with minimal use of energy, and maintaining the natural biodiversity undisturbed, with potential for attaining Net Zero with economical remedial measures during the years following.

The remediation gap between the assessed footprint and the available remediation is 228.7 Ton CO_2 eq. On a closer look, the major contributors are:

- 1. Transportation (223.5 T of CO₂)
- 2. Wastes (20.3 T of CO2), and
- 3. Use of Purchased Electricity (16.7 T of CO₂)

The College may seriously consider more remediation options, in spite of its very low CF status. Being a college with moderate use of personal vehicles like the use of scooters/bikes, and cars, the present 78% share of carbon footprint through Transportation is largely due to large number of students daily commuting by bus, as students from outside the town also form a major part of the daily commuting set of students.

The College maintains greenery through maintenance of its extensive natural forest kept in tack, and a butterfly garden, as well as minimal gardening. Investing in Solar photo voltaic power generation in bulk – say a 50 kW roof top PV plant – can offset a good share of total Carbon Footprints, in addition to making electricity purchase burden to nil and earn some money back as well for almost a quarter century.

Energy Audit for the academic year 2021- '22 has been conducted at S N College, Alathur, Palakkad 678 682, Kerala, in accordance with the International Standards for ISO 14000 family of standards set by ISO TC 207 and its Subcommittees, Bureau of Energy Efficiency Standards, and stipulations under the Energy Conservation Act 2021 of Government of India, and other relevant mandates for maintenance of sustainable and healthy environment for education in the campus.

In our opinion, the Institution has presented true and up-to-date data on relevant activities to the audit team, and appropriate audit procedures have been completed for issuing this Audit Certificate and the Compliance Statement. The recommendations are based on verified data presented as they existed at the time of audit.

The inspection methodology did combine physical inspection of the campus, with analytical reviews of relevant documents and activities, as well as interviews with Principal and selected members of Staff and Students of the College.

Audit findings indicate that, of the 285.3 T CO₂ of actual carbon footprint of the institution for the year, the contribution from direct use of electricity (Firewood use is eliminated completely) was only at 16.7 T CO₂. Transportation including public transport use (outside the campus) is at 134 T CO₂. Wastes contributed 20.3 T CO₂. Wastes to energy thro' biogas is yet to be seriously attempted. Effective awareness and training programs were conducted during the year and are planned for the future as well, to make all stakeholders aware and up-to-date on the need for individual efforts.




4. World ozone day observed- 16/09/2017


16.CANCER - Come, Let Us Know It Better!! - 04/02/2018






14. Milk quality testing from different Milk collection centres in alathur panchayat- socio institutional responsibility.



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
Clean and green campus initiatives: 2020-2021

3. VEGETABLE GARDEN





Awareness among students and Kudumbasree units for self-employment-by NSS Units.




5. MUSHROOM CULTIVATION – 20/08/2020




11.OCTOBER 2-8 WILDLIFE WEEK 2020


20. Field visit to Nelliyampathy with 2019-2021 and 2020-2022 batch.

6. WATER QUALITY ANALYSIS




Microbiology department conducted a water quality analysis test to identify the portability of drinking water from different areas. The test was conducted at microbiology lab, first we collected water samples from different areas and the test is done through different steps. The presumptive is screening test to the sample water for the presence of coliform organisms. Some water samples show negative to this test and some shows positive. The positive tested samples considered as unsafe—so the confirmed test is performed. For this, a loopful of suspension from a positive tube were inoculated, then examined microscopically. Through this test, we can identify the drinking water quality.









The Government have reviewed the Covid 19 Pandemic situation prevailing in the state and have decided to depute Gazetted Officers as Sectoral Magistrates to enforce the containment measures. It is reported that a sharp increase in COVID-19 cases has been observed along with high positivity rate in many panchayaths in this district. Considering this unprecedented surge, there is an urgent need for strict enforcement of COVID control measures, in the surge areas to bring the situation under control.

Inaddition to the officers who were posted to identify violations of GOVID 19 protocols vide orders read above, the following officers are also deputed as Sectoral Magistrates for the enforcement of quarantine (List appended). All the designated Officials has to reinvigorate the activities of the Rapid Respose Team (RRT) to undertake listing of Covid cases, contacts and mapping. The prime responsibilities of the Sectoral Magistrates are to ensure that the RRTs

Identify, isolate the Covid positive patients and constantly monitor whether the quarantine rules are strictly adhered to by them.

2) Undertake mapping of Covid cases and their contacts(atleast 5 contacts per positive cases.)

3) Conduct house to house surveillance, listing of vulnerable and symptomatic persons

4) update the details of positive and quarantined persons in Covid 19 Jagratha portal.

The Sectoral Magistrates (Quarantine Enforcement) have to be in contact with the Medical Officers, LSGI Secretaries ,SHO and all other department officials who are engaged in Covid containment activities and the enforcement activities as per the guidelines in their respective jurisdictions.


17. ALUMINI 2020-2021












6. JUNE 14 - WORLD BLOOD DONOR DAY 2021




8. INTERNATIONAL YOGA AND MUSIC DAY




10. WORLD NATURE CONSERVATION DAY



15.11'SEPTEMBER/2021 VEGETABLE HARVEST



17.International Ozone Day Celebration




19.AIDS AWARNESS CLASS - 30-09-2021




23.HAIR DONATION CAMP


24.BIRD WATCHING


48.Hepatitis Know & Act – 04/08/2022

4. WATER QUALITY ANALYSIS



Water quality analysis is also called hydro-chemical analysis. That is to use chemical and physical methods to determine the content of various chemical components in water. Water quality analysis can be divided into three types: simple analysis, complete analysis and special analysis. Water quality analysis of nearby wells, pond and quarry was conducted. Simple analysis was conducted which include estimation of dissolved oxygen, pH, temperature and dissolved Carbondioxide. It was found that phosphate and iron content was slightly higher but was under desired consumption limit.

5. A programme named 'Nooril Noor'(നൂറിൽ നൂറ്)

It was inaugurated by M.V. Rasmi Agricultural officer, Alathur. Dr. R. Bindu presided over the function. Vegetable Seedling were didtributed among 100 students. 7. Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav


