The name of the college “Sree Narayana College” Alathur is the name of the spiritual and social reformer of India- “Sree Narayana Guru ” who lived during 18th century and has led reform movement against injustice in the caste ridden society of Kerala in order to promote spiritual enlightenment and social equality and coined the slogan “ one caste , one religion and one god for all .”Sree Narayana Guru profounds education as the primary concern by which he believed that one could uplift his/her quality of life.

Every day college begins with the prayer “ Daivadasakam ” written by “SreeNarayana Guru”. The college aims at the upliftment and advancement of youth, especially those who belong to economically and socially backward areas and communities, through the propagation of the views and ideas of Sree Narayana Guru , the great seer who advocated complete emancipation through education . The motto of our college is “Seek freedom and enlightenment through education” of the words of Guru. Our institution trains the youth in inculcating resourcefulness, initiative, self confidence and leadership qualities and help students to keep abreast of the modern age of science and technology by moulding them as competent and committed citizens.

The College is situated in rural area of Alathur Panchayath of Palakkad District, and many of our students are from economically and socially backward sectors of society ,and also first generation learners. But still we got around 90% pass percentage with majority first class and distinction. Majority of them also availing different scholarships and E-grants provided by government and different authorities.

Many certificate and add on courses are offered by different departments which enables students to get more career oriented knowledge in order to cope up the current competitive situation.

SreeNarayana College always places a strong emphasis on creating an inclusive atmosphere through acceptance of differences and diversity.The institution commemorate all the important days with national as well as international relevance hence making the students understand the fundamental responsibilities, duties that one should abide by to become an asset to the society

The college has initiated a lot of awareness sessions like anti narcotic, gender studies , grievance redressal, Entrepreneurship,etc through the functioning of various clubs and committees. Other Environment awareness programmes are also organized by the college

like wetland day, ozone day, Environment day ,World pollution control day ,wild life week , Bird watching day , world hand wash day ,National doctors day ,Tiger day .Nagasakhi day , Nature conservation day, Hindi divas, Blood donation day , Aids day etc.

Independence Day and republic day, Ghandhi Jayanthi, azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav, Prem chand divas are celebrated with full zeal and zest.Regional and national festivals like Onam,Christmas ,Ramdan etc also celebrated with great enthusiasm.

The college has followed the two best practices named ;

Best Practice- I : 'NERARIVU' :-Creating and Empowering Responsible citizens to make a difference in the local environment.For this the institution has conducted diverse activities to propagate to social values that gives importance to individual as a fundamental aspects of society.

The college has taken care of social obligations also ,by providing possible assistance to the nearby locality .During the catastrophic Kerala floods occurred in 2018 the students and staffs of the college involved in various social services. During the pandemic period the College hostel and classrooms were used for CFLTC(Covid First Line Treatment Centre) for Kavassery Grama Panchayath from April 2020 to 15th of June 2020. Teachers Students and Alumnea have contribued 25000 rupees for buying Hand Sanitizers and Face Mask. Some of our teachers and Students worked as volunteers for the same.

As a part of Calicut University project “ABHAYAM ,”the NSS unit of our college has constructed a house by collective mobilisation from the public, students and teachers and donated to a poor meritorious student of the college.

Best Practice-II 'AARANYAKAM' -"Come let us adorn the earth with verdant environment ":- Programs, that help creating an awareness among the students about the fact that each creature in this universe is depended upon the nature were organized by different clubs such as Nature club, Energy club, Bio diversity club and Birds club.

In an attempt to create awareness among students about environment and its significance, all the departments take active participation in conducting programmes towards the same end. World environment day and ozone day are extensively celebrated and competitions are arranged. Fire belts are installed around the campus to protect it from forest fires. The college has installed 4 KW solar panel and thereby encourages nature friendly energy consumption.

In order to keep waste free campus, the college has extensive provision for bio-compost preparation. All the waste materials are well sorted and properly managed. In association with the Department of Microbiology, efforts are taken to check the air, water and soil quality. In an attempt to create a plastic free campus, all the waste plastic materials are collected and recycled. Used bottles are re used as containers for various purposes..

The college has provision for rain shelter which has been constructed with the idea to protect crops from damages caused by heavy rainfall. Programmes to impart information regarding the importance of ground water recharging are regularly conducted by various departments and the college has well executed provisions for the same as well.



The college maintained more than three acres of bio diversity park is and regularly documented and also a vegetable garden which promotes the green life through various measures. The flora and fauna life inside the campus is given prime importance and accordingly campus has more than 18 acres of rain forest land.





The college also creates disabled friendly environment by introducing great measures to provide all facilities for people with disability concerns. Separate pathways ,wheel chairs and special toilet and sanitary requirements are provided. Scribes for students with difficulties are provided by the campus.






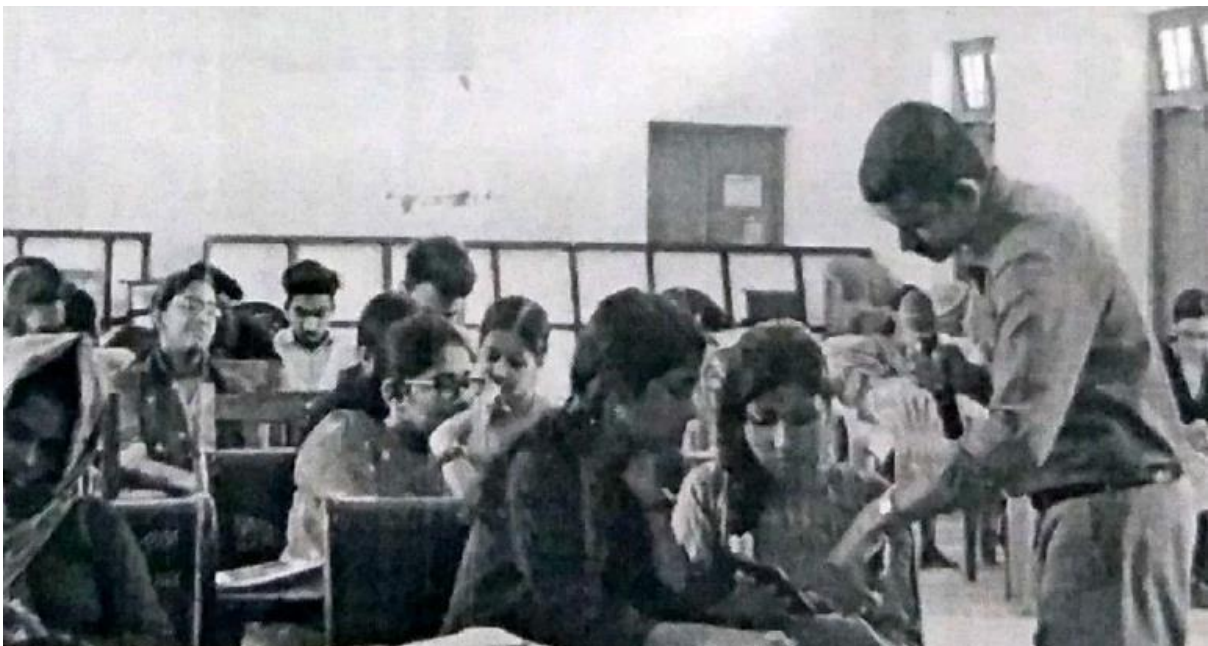
7. ECO FILM FEST :4/10/2017

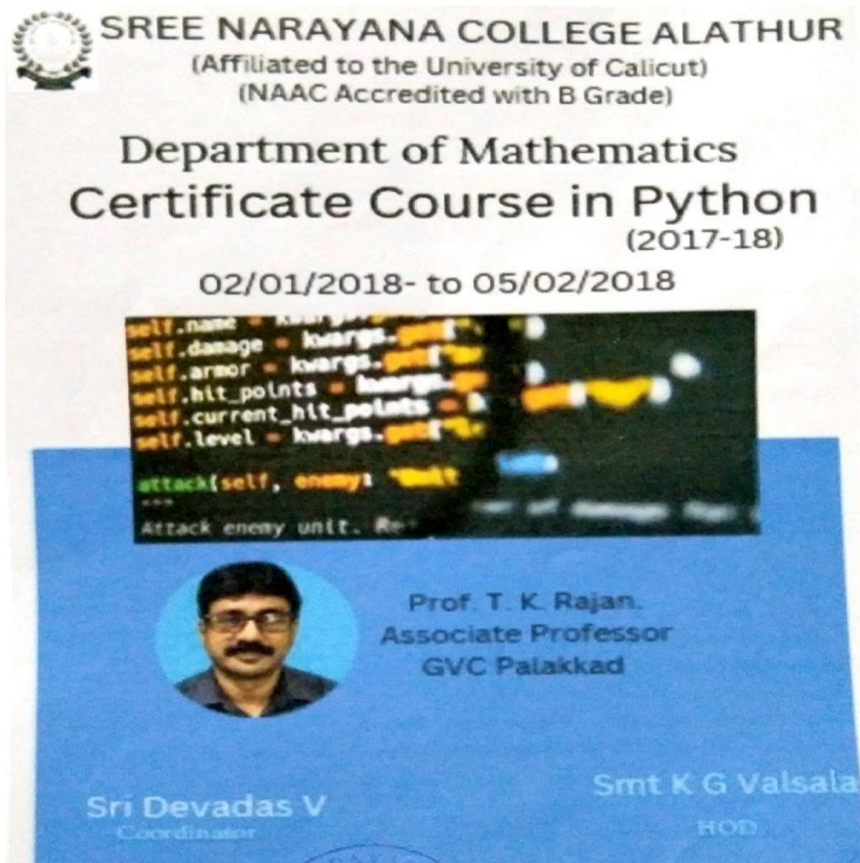
9. VEGETABLE GARDEN- ORGANIC FARMING:

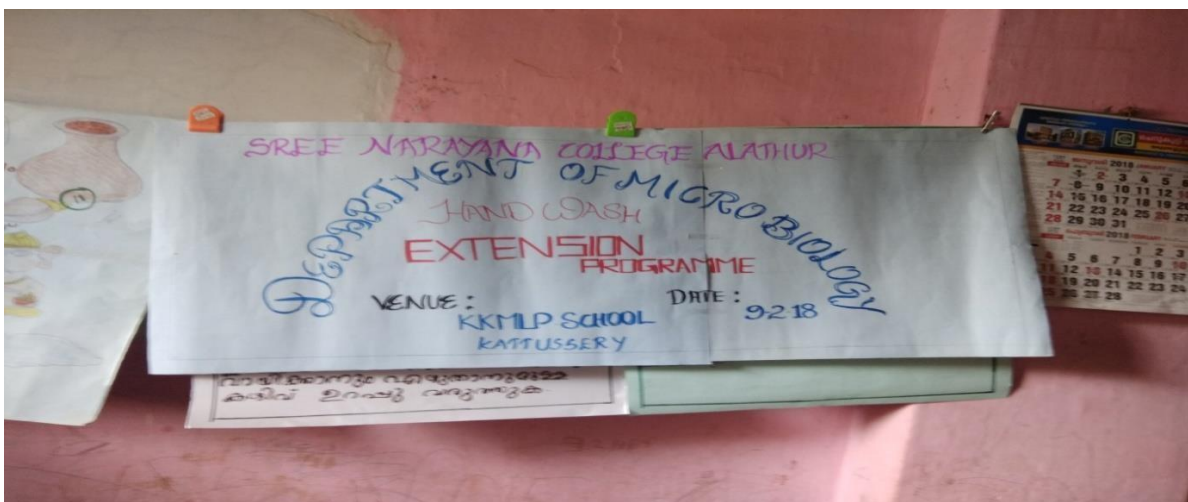
11. Biocompost

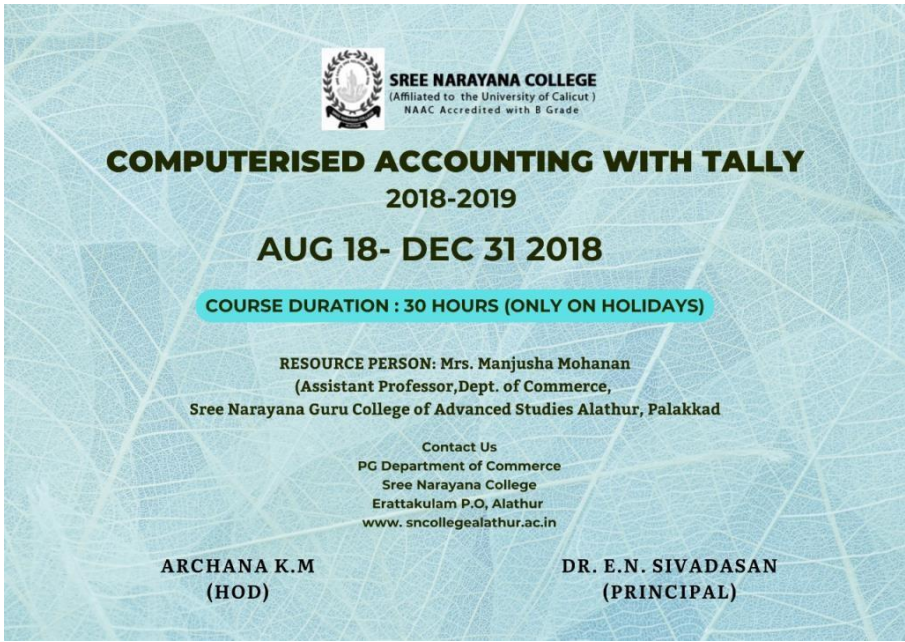

3. Add On Course-PG Department Of Commerce (60hrs)

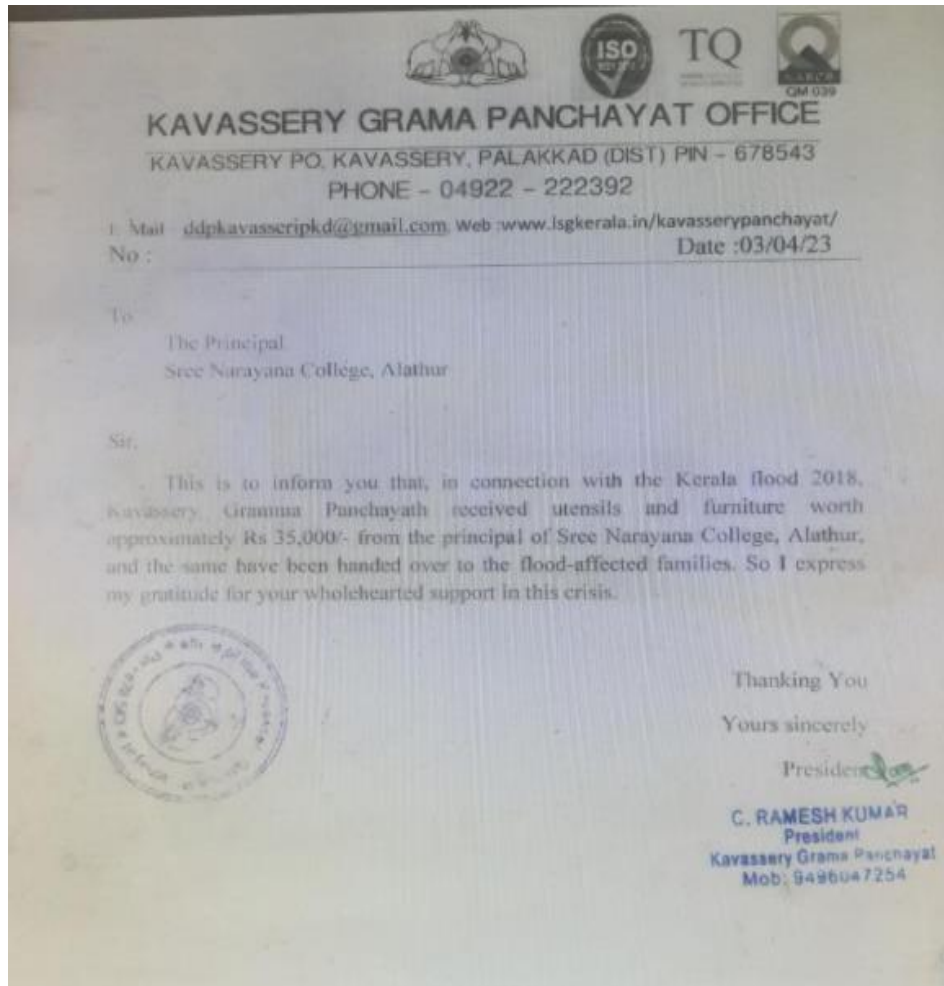

6. Ground Water Recharging (21-11-2018)

Kerala is blessed with a lot's rainfall during two different seasons in a year. The South-west monsoon occurs between June and December, and from October to December there will be North –East monsoon. During these two monsoons almost all the water bodies overflow. But due to the peculiar nature of land in Kerala, which is sloping from east to west, water flows very quickly into the sea.

As a result of the floods in August -2018 in Kerala, the top - most layer of the earth got covered with clay, which does not allow the surface water to penetrate underground. There by, ground water level started decreasing.

Palakkad district in Kerala suffers from drought every year. Especially the border areas of Palakkad like Eruthempathy, Vadakarapathy, Kozhinjampara etc suffer from drought even in the monsoon season. Drinking water is supplied in vehicles during the monsoon seasons. Bore well is drilled up to 1500 ft down the earth but still water is not available.

To overcome this dire situation, the NSS team of Sree Narayana (SN) College, Alathur, took up the challenge to improve the ground water levels in our locality through rain water harvesting. Our college is a Government Aided college under the management of Sree Narayana Trusts in Palakkad district, Kerala, affiliated to university of Calicut, Kerala. It was established in 1970.

We have two National Service Scheme (NSS) units, unit no 37 & 117 of which, Smt. Poornima P.L and Sri.Jiju K.R are the Program Officers. There are about 200 volunteers under these two units.

Awareness Program

In order to understand the need and relevance of ground water a talk is given to the students on the topic “Ground water resources; problems, constraints & challenges” on 15/11/2018. The session was handled by Dr. Dipu S, Scientist B, Water quality division, Centre for Water Resources, Development and Management (CWRDM).



Training

The NSS units of SN College, in collaboration with ‘Dhisa’, planned to implement ground water recharging units in various schools in Alathur. For the same a technical team from Centre for water Resources Development and Management (CWRDM), Calicut, under the guidance of Dr. Harikumar P. S, Head & Senior Principal Scientist, Water Quality Division visited our college on 21. 12.2018 and trained our volunteers. The technical sessions were handled by Sri. Sasidharan Pallikudian, Technical officer, Construction & Maintenance Wing.



Training Sessions

The process

A brief description of the process is as follows: Rain water collected from the roof with PVC Sheets is then sent to a filtration unit through PVC pipes. The filtration unit consist of a tank of 1000-2000 litre capacity depends on the catchment area, three different layers the top layer consist of tiny gravels or sand for sedimentation of large sized particles, the middle layer consists of charcoal for adsorbing chemical contaminates if any present and the bottom layer consist of large gravels. Each layer is separated from the other with nylon nets. Each layer consists of 15-20 cm height depending on the contamination level of the atmosphere. After filtration the pure water is allowed to flows either to an open well or bore well.

Implementation

During the seven - day residential Camp of NSS from 22/11/2018 to 28/11/2018 at GUPS Puthiyakam, we installed eleven ground water recharging units in various schools in seven panchayaths in Alathur. A brief description of the process is as follows: Rain water collected from the roof with PVC Sheets is then sent to a filtration unit through PVC pipes. The filtration unit consist of a tank of 1000-2000 litre capacity depends on the catchment area, three different layers the top layer consist of tiny gravels or sand for sedimentation of large sized particles, the middle layer consists of charcoal for adsorbing chemical contaminates if any present and the bottom layer consist of large gravels. Each layer is separated from the other with nylon nets. Each layer consists of 15-20 cm height depending on the contamination level of the atmosphere. After filtration the pure water is allowed to flows either to an open well or bore well.

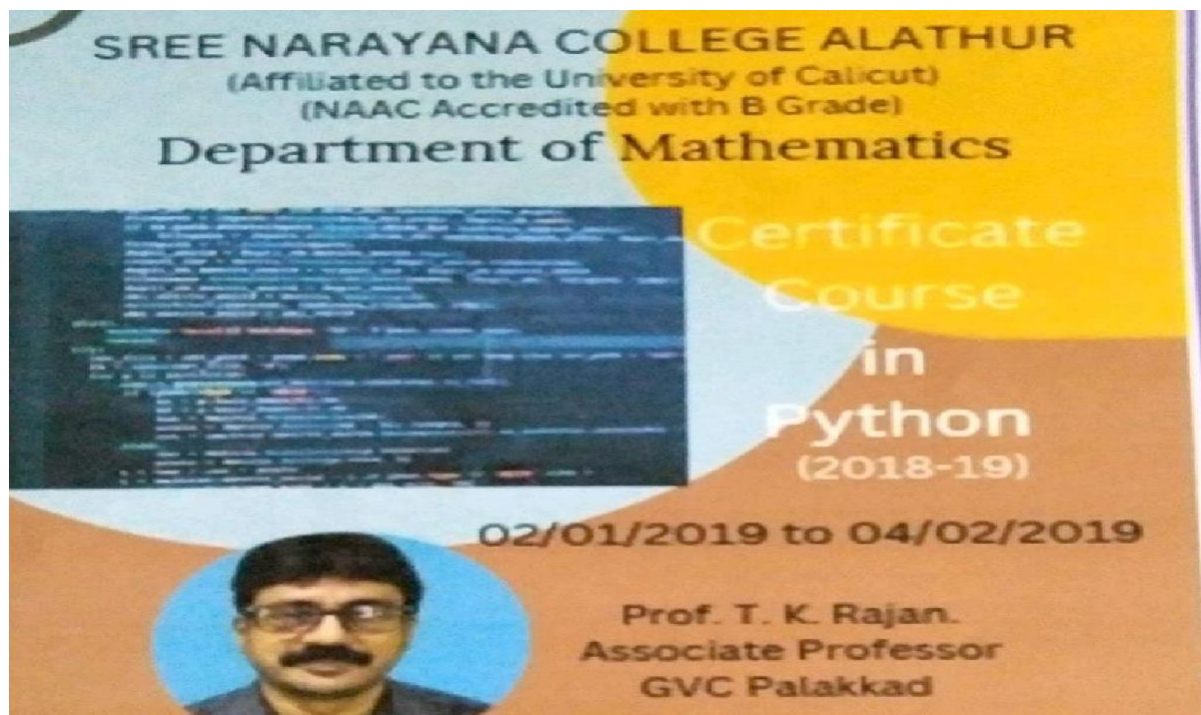
7. GOLDEN JUBILEE SCIENCE EXPO EXHIBITION (08.02.2019 to 11.02.19)

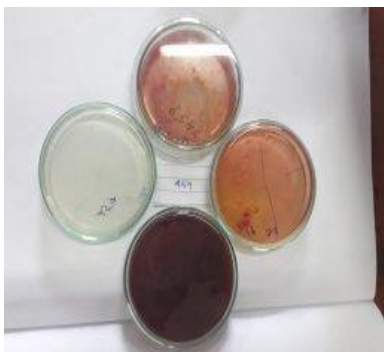


2. Wheel chair for physically disabled students(25-07-2019)

Department of Microbiology introduced a Bio compost unit using the vegetable and leaf wastes available in the campus for getting awareness and improving self employability among students and society



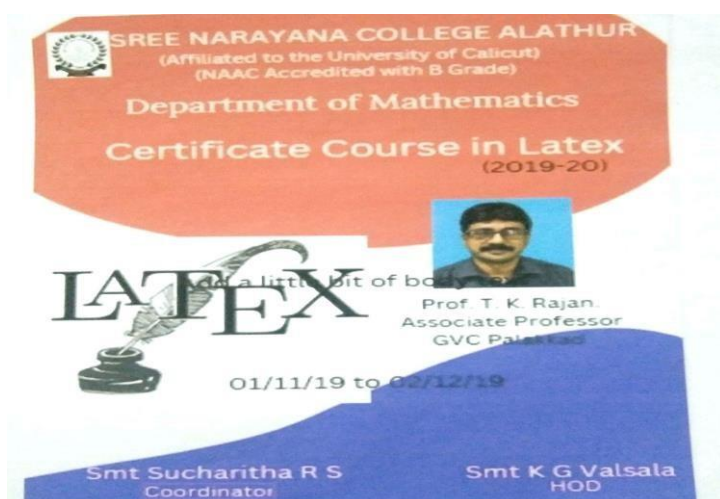
4. Bio compost Pit (28-10-2019)

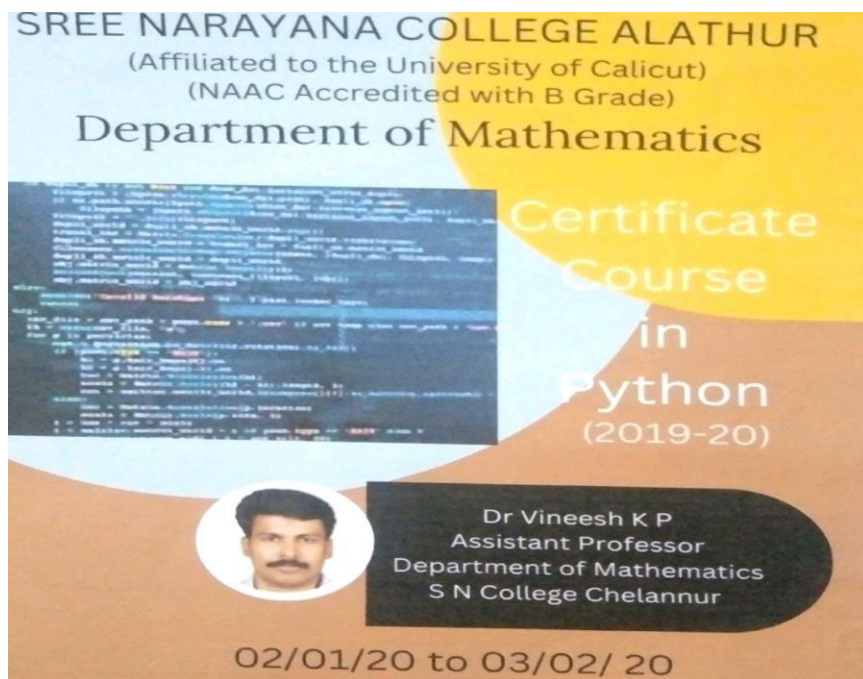

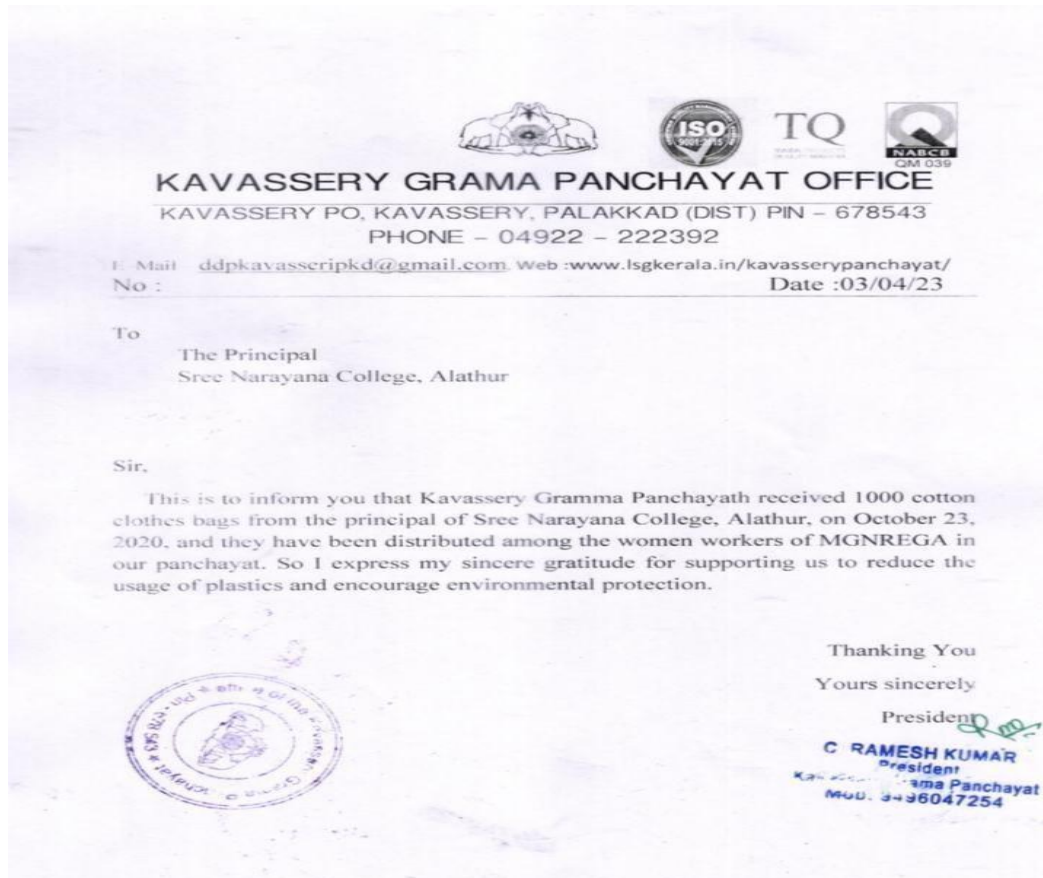


13. Exhibition -Thalir-2.0(30-01-2020)
