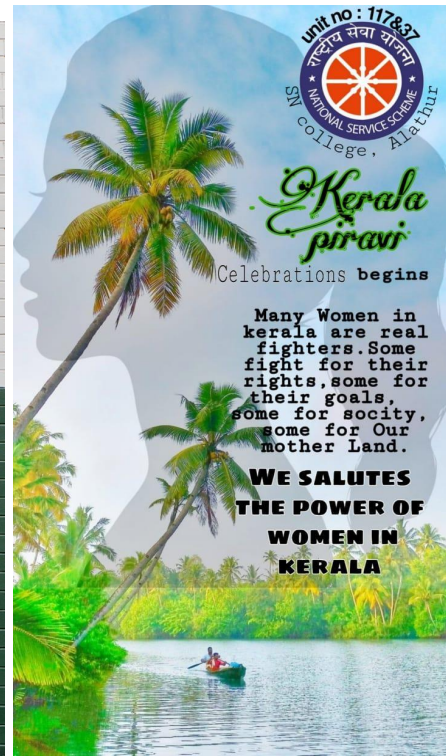
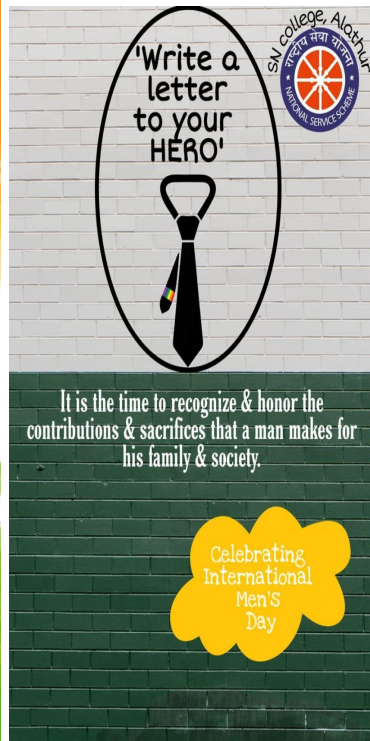
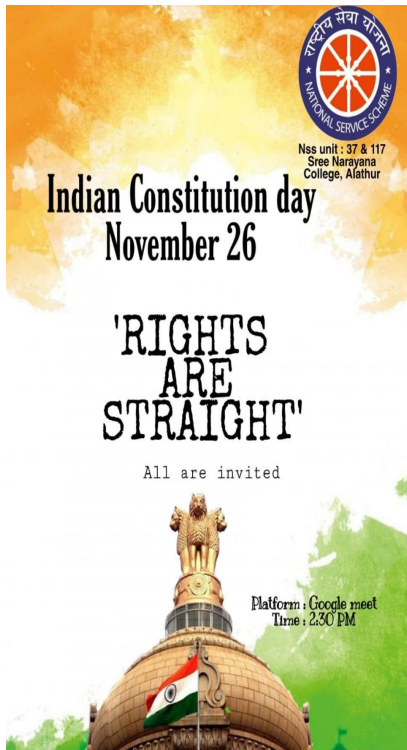


Indian Constitution Day 26/11/2020

GRIEVANCE CELL


