





STUDY TOUR

SOCIO INSTITUTIONAL RESPONSIBILITY:

1. ASTREET VENDED FOODS:

Palakkad district is very famous for street vended foods, because it is very economical, lot of varieties are available, lack of time for self preparation of food etc., so the Project on Screening of microbial pathogens from the street vended foods available in the Alathur panchayat were done in order to create an awareness among the public about the unhygienic practices during cooking and handling, less quality raw materials used etc., and outbreak of food borne diseases were highlighted in the report.

2. WATER QUALITY ANALYSIS:

Microbiology department conducted a water quality analysis test to identify the portability of drinking water from different areas. Based on the result, public awareness were given to drink boiled water, filter water or chlorinated water.

AIR QUALITY ANALYSIS:

Air contains a variety of micro organisms, the actual types and numbers depending upon the environment considered. This experiment shows variations in the microbial contents in the air due to sweeping and dusting. The information gained from this type of experiment can be used in microbiology laboratories to have an idea an of the contaminants where isolation and culturing experiments are carried out in an atmosphere of still air.

4. SOIL QUALITY ANALYSIS:

To isolate and enumerate viable microbial cells present in the soil near the laboratory effluent discharge system by spread plate method.

International Ozone Day Celebration



Microbiology department conducted a water quality analysis test to identify the portability of drinking water from different areas. The test was conducted at microbiology lab, first we collected water samples from different areas and the test is done through different steps. The presumptive is screening test to the sample water for the presence of coliform organisms. Some water samples shows negative to this test and some shows positive. The positive tested samples considered as unsafe—so the confirmed test is performed. For this, a loopful of suspension from a positive tube were inoculated, then examined macroscopically. Through this test we can identify the drinking water quality.

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


2. Haiku writing competition:





1. Invited lecture:




2. Photographycompetition:


3. International Ozone Day Celebration

Finally the 7 days residential camp was concluded by taking group photos. All the NSS volunteers said goodbye with grief.







Waste Management and Energy Conservation Measures Inside the Campus.

The college has taken up several measures waste management and energy conservation in the campus. It has well installed vermi compost and bio gas plants. And the rain water is carefully harvested and put to effective use.









The instituition has facilities for

1)Alternate sources of energy and energy conservation measures.

In an attempt to create awareness among students about environment and its significance, all the departments take active participation in conducting programmes towards the same end.

- i) World environment day and ozone day are extensively celebrated and competitions are arranged.
- ii) Fire belts are installed around the campus to protect it from forest fires.
- iii) Manufactures reusable LED bulbs, the service of which is not limited to students but to locals as well.

2) Management of various types of degradable and nondegradable waste.

- i) The department of E.W.M. in their attempts to keep a waste free campus, conducts a programme Nattaruvikal on regular basis. The programme is installed so as to conduct regular checks on the cleanliness inside the campus.
- ii) The college has extensive provision for bio-compost preparation. All the waste materials are well sorted and properly managed.
- iii) In association with the Department of Microbiology, efforts are taken to check the air, water and soil quality.
- iv) In an attempt to create a plastic free campus, all the waste plastic materials are collected and recycled. Used bottles are re used as containers for various purposes.
- v) Students are motivated to extend their commitment towards a clean earth beyond the boundaries of the campus. There are occasional river side cleanings conducted by students in the suburbs.
- vi) The well installed vermi compost provision inside the campus is yet another initiative by the campus in its management of waste materials.

3) Water conservation

- i) The college has provision for rain shelter which has been constructed with the idea to protect crops from damages caused by heavy rainfall. This in turn is opened for service to the locals as well.
- ii) Programmes to impart information regarding the importance of ground water recharging are regularly conducted and the college had well executed provisions for the same as well.

- ii) More than three acres of bio diversity park is maintained and taken care of towards green campus initiatives. The plants in the park are regularly documented. - iii) The college maintains a well organised vegetable garden.
