Best Practice-I:

'NERARIVU':-Creating and Empowering Responsible citizens to make a difference in the local environment.

The institution has conducted diverse activities to propagate to social values that gives importance to individual as a fundamental aspects of society. The activities were organized under the aegis of NCC, NSS, Women cell, Debate club, ED club etc. socially relevant programs inculcating human values, gender

equality communal harmony, and a universal code of ethics. The fundamental objective of the institution is

to make every student a 'change agent 'who is aware of the role to play in their community and to enrich

the students with basic humanitarian concerns.

Intention:-

1.To promote a student-friendly atmosphere to enrich the students with ideas to make them more

responsible in all spheres of life

2.To empower students to make a difference in the local environment and community and thereby

creating compassionate and productive citizens

3.To empower women and ensure maximum participation inside and outside the campus with

vision to withstand the present competitive scenario.

Frame of reference:-

The majority of the students enrolled are from socially and economically backward communities. Therefore, the institution stands to uplift and nurture them with universal qualities and social awareness. The last five years were tough times for everyone to survive. It was during this period students came forward with relevant activities with full spirit. Mid-day meals program: The distribution of food kits, Cleaning Programmes inside and outside the Campus, Blood Donation Camp, hair donation for Cancer patients, ground water recharging system, distribution of bio-compost, Distribution of Pulse Oxi metre, Distribution of flood relief classes and donated books for school students. Teachers are taken different services in the Covid affected area.

Implementation:-

The institution provides an inclusive environment, tolerance and harmony towards cultural, regional, religious, linguistic, and other activities. Sensitization of students and employees in the institution to the constitutional obligations, values, rights, duties, gender

equality, and responsibilities of the institution are emphasized in order to make them responsible to the society in which they belong to. The following initiatives were taken in the institutional level. Conducted orientation and moulding sessions which offered physical strength, fitness and confidence to students. Stress management classes were arranged to release their tensions even at difficult times. As most of the students in the college are girls, special motivational and counselling sessions were arranged for their upliftment. Programs like Mithra, Janani were arranged and appreciate the humanitarian approaches shown by students. Awareness classes were arranged Anaemia to make them realise how to handle the diseases. Blood Donation camps are regularly organised in the campus. Students and teachers take keen interest in donating blood. Entrepreneurship initiatives among students through manufacturing soaps, sanitizers and cloth bags. literate in which parents and women in the neighbourhood participated. Flood relief materials were collected by teachers and students and distributed in the relief camps. During the pandemic period, students had taken initiatives to sanitize the surroundings of affected houses, relief camps and they distributed free food kits. Rabies awareness class, traffic awareness program are very effective classes.

Programs, that help creating an awareness among the students about the fact that each creature in this universe is depended upon the nature were organized by different clubs such as Nature club, Energy club, Bio diversity club and Birds club. Ground water recharging, The Vegetable Garden, Butterfly Park, Medicinal plants, rain water harvesting, bio diversity park, 'pakshikalkkoru dhahajalam' program, rain shelter and Organic farming are the notable initiatives to keep the campus eco-friendly.

Intention:-

- 1.To promote sustainable lifestyle
- 2.To preserve nature
- 2.To promote eco friendly atmosphere

Frames of reference:-

Waste management is essential to ensure and maintain greenery on the campus. The waste management technique in the institution is initiated with the motto of reducing, reusing, and recycling in order to maintain greenery and beauty, thus making the institution clean and healthy. Campus cleaning programs are conducted regularly to maintain cleanliness.

Implementation:-

Students have taken an oath to keep their surroundings neat and clean and not to harm the environment. Cleaning and campus beautification programs are conducted regularly. Green audit and Energy audit are done as part of the green initiative.

Baskets are contributed to every classrooms and staff rooms to dump the plastic and non-plastic waste. To ensure the cleanliness and beauty of the campus, the college initiated an MoU with the Agency. Two separate tri colour bins are placed inside the campus to dump plastic and non-plastic wastes. The Haritha karma sena workers collect the plastic wastes once a month and it is further reused and recycled efficiently for making other products. Vermicompost is maintained and the decomposed non- plastic wastes are used as manures to nourish the vegetation in the campus. Eco-friendly product exhibitions and awareness classes are conducted regularly.

Result:-

The campus has evolved to become an eco-friendly campus, with low rate of plastic waste. Efforts are taken to periodically check and update the bio diversity park and butterfly garden. It maintains a well-groomed medicinal garden. N.S.S. unit in campus participated in a tree maintenance competition held under the banner Green Kerala Mission by Kerala Government and planted more than 6000 saplings in the premises and secured first position in Kerala.


2.BOOKS DONATED TO LP SCHOOL LIBRARY, ERATTAKKULAM

4. Ground Water Recharging

SreeNarayana(SN) College, Alathur is a Government Aided college under the management of SreeNarayana Trusts in Palakkad district, Kerala. It is affiliated to university of Calicut, in Kerala. It was established in 1970. At present, 8 under graduate(Including a B.Sc degree coursein Environment and Water Management) and 4 post graduate courses are offered here. Dr.E.N Sivadasan is our principal.Our college has two National Service Scheme (NSS) units, unit no 37 & 117 of which, SmtPoornima P.L and Sri.Jiju K.R are the Program Officers respectively. There are about 200 volunteers under these two units. 'Disha' is an initiative by Hon. MLA, Sri K.D Prasenan of Alathur legislative assembly, for enhancing the facilities in the public schools in his legislative assembly. Sri. V.J Johnson is the coordinator of 'Disha'. The NSS units of SN College, in collaboration with 'Dhisa', planned to implement ground water recharging units in various schools in Alathur. For the same a technical team from Centre for water Resources Development and Management (CWRDM), Calicut, under the guidance of Dr. Harikumar P. S,Head & Senior Principal Scientist, Water Quality Division visited our college on 21. 12.2018 and trained our volunteers. The technical sessions were handled by Sri. SasidharanPallikudian, Technical officer, Construction &Maintance Wing.





Training Sessions

Implementation

During the seven - day residential Camp of NSS from 22/11/2018 to 28/11/2018 at GUPS Puthiyakam, we installed eleven ground water recharging units in various schools in seven panchayaths in Alathur. A brief description of the process is as follows: Rain water collected from the roof with PVC Sheets is then sent to a filtration unit through PVC pipes. The filtration unit consist of a tank of 1000-2000 litre capacity depends on the catchment area, three different layers the top layer consist of tiny gravels or sand for sedimentation of large sized particles, the middle layer consists of charcoal for adsorbing chemical contaminates if any present and the bottom layer consist of large gravels. Each layer is separated from the other with nylon nets. Each layer consists of 15-20 cm height depending on the contamination level of the atmosphere. After filtration the pure water is allowed to flows either to an open well or bore well.








14.HAIR DONATION CAMP
