

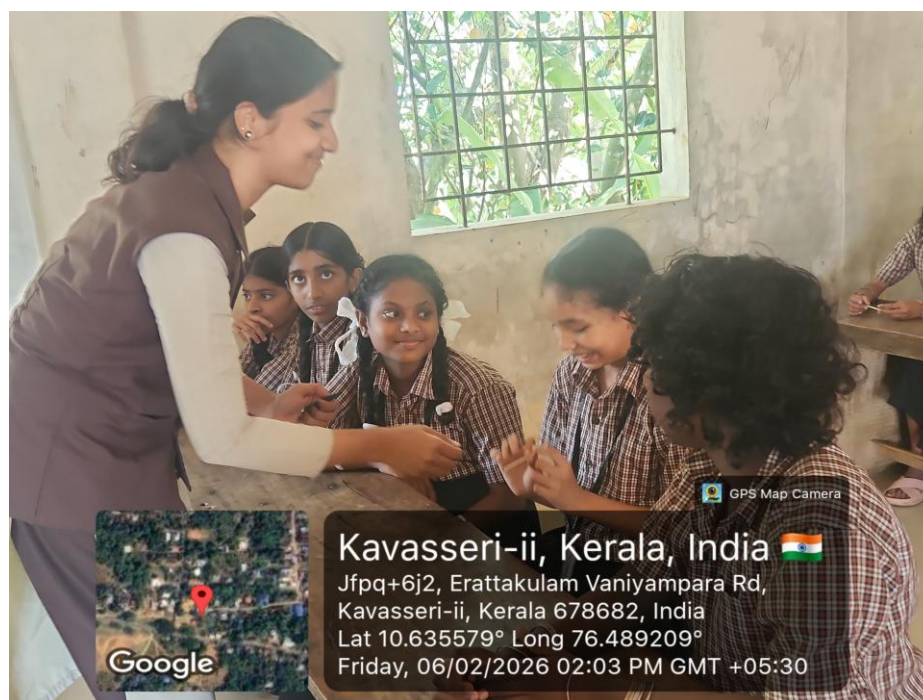
## REPORT ON EXTENSION ACTIVITY: MICROTEACHING AT SARIGA PUBLIC SCHOOL

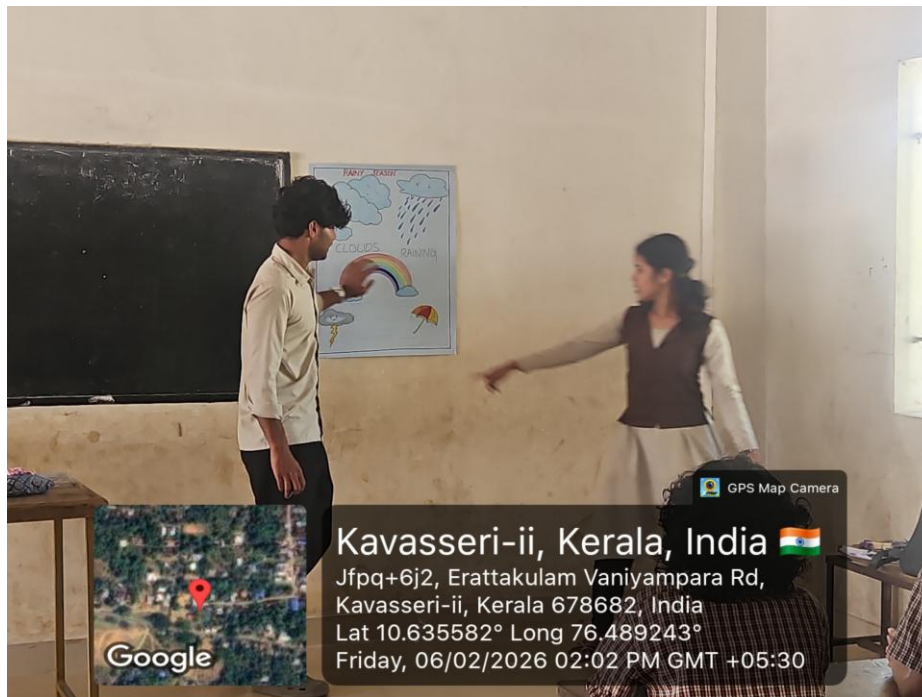

The event was designed to provide practical teaching experience to third year BA Functional English students while fostering interactive learning for primary students.
