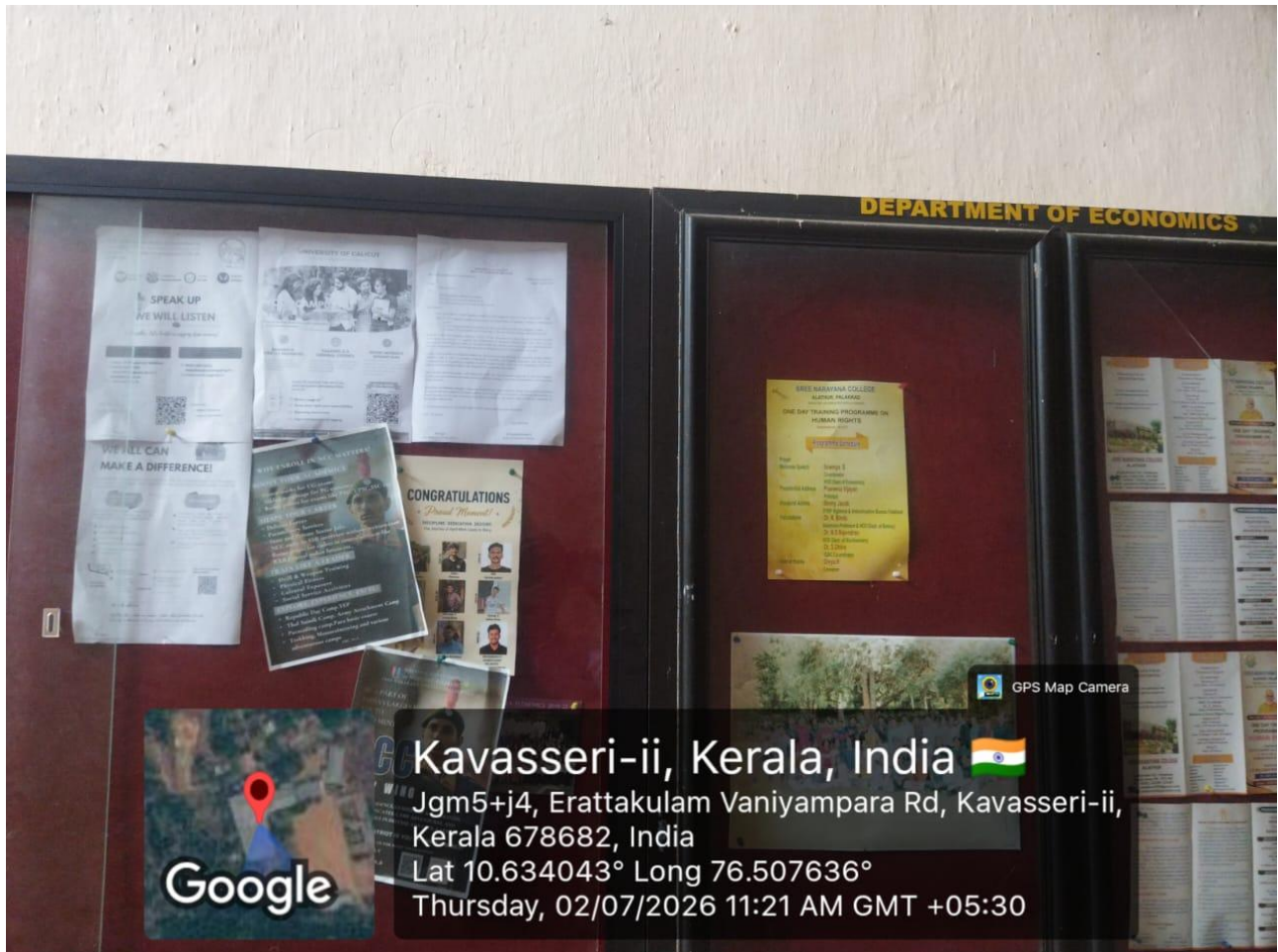


ANTIRAGGING AWARENESS REPORT

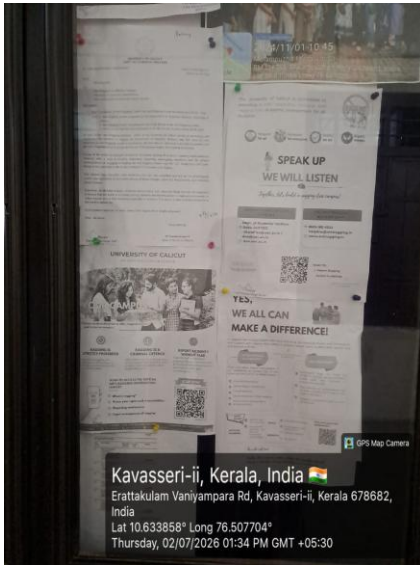
